This year N-C spent \$594,012 in the education fund compared to \$591,304 spent in the education fund last year. In the operation and maintenance fund, N-C spent \$97,627 this year compared to last year the district had spent

\$58,796. The district spent \$97,670 this year in the transportation fund compared to \$97,870 last year. The district spent \$789,309 this year compared to \$740,970 last year at this time in those three funds for a difference of \$48,339 more this year compared to last year.

The 30th of September completed 25% of the 2018 fiscal year. The district expended 22.4% of the education budget, 26.2% of the operations and maintenance budget, and 37.0% of the transportation budget.

Fund balances as of September 30, 2018: Education: \$506,501, Operation and Maintenance: \$396,607, Transportation: \$288,096, and Working Cash: \$182,720. The four Major Fund Balances: \$1,373,924. Total Fund Balance for all funds: \$2,289,346.

Fund balances as of September 30, 2017: Education: \$634,733, Building: \$369,528, Transportation: \$155,991 and Working Cash: \$146,222. The four Major Fund Balances: \$1,306,474. Total Fund Balance for all funds: \$2,339,774.

The district has \$67,450 more this year compared to last year in the four major funds. The district has \$50,428 less this year compared to last year in total fund balance.
